

Latin Name: *Genista sagittalis*
Common Name: Winged Broom
Family: Fabaceae
Geographic Origin: Europe and Western Asia



Soil: This plant will grow best in moist, organically rich, well-drained soils.

Temperature: Temperatures during the day should be between 70°-80°F and should be between 60°-70°F at night.

Light: This plant should be placed in an area of full sun.

Moisture: Water this plant every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every year or two. Prune overextending branches when needed.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate from seeds or stem cuttings.

Pests and diseases: Check for mealy bugs and whitefly.
