
Family: Malvaceae

Geographic Origin: Tropical Asia

Soil: This plant prefers well-drained soil.

<u>Temperature:</u> Daytime temperatures should be between 70°-80°F and nighttime temperatures should be between 60°-70°F.

<u>Light:</u> Place in an area of full sun to partial shade.





<u>Fertilization:</u> This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every two-three years. Prune back branches when needed.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

<u>Propagation:</u> Propagate from stem cuttings or seeds.

<u>Pests and diseases:</u> Susceptible to whitefly, mealy bugs, and scale.
