

Latin Name: *Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*
Common Name: China Hibiscus
Family: Malvaceae
Geographic Origin: Tropical Asia

Soil: This plant prefers well-drained soil.

Temperature: Daytime temperatures should be between 70°-80°F and nighttime temperatures should be between 60°-70°F.

Light: Place in an area of full sun to partial shade.

Moisture: Water every two-three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every two-three years. Prune back branches when needed.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate from stem cuttings or seeds.

Pests and diseases: Susceptible to whitefly, mealy bugs, and scale.
