

Latin Name: *Ficus benjamina*
Common Name: Benjamin's Fig
Family: Moraceae
Geographic Origin: Asia

Soil: Use a well-draining soil mix.

Temperature: Daytime temperatures should be between 70°-80°F and nighttime temperatures should be between 60°-70°F.

Light: Place in an area that is partially shaded.



Moisture: Water every two-three days, allowing the plant to dry out a little between watering.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every two-three years. Prune when needed.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during summer months.

Propagation: Propagate through stem cuttings.

Pests and diseases: Check for root rot, scale, and mealy bugs.

Common Name: Rock Fig
Family: Moraceae
Geographic Origin: Mexico

Soil: This plant prefers a rocky, well-draining soil

Temperature: Daytime temperatures should be between 70°-80°F and nighttime temperatures should be between 80°-90°F.

Light: Place in an area of full sun to partial shade.

Moisture: Water every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every two to three years. Prune back unwanted growth.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate through seeds, air layering, or stem cuttings.

Pests and diseases: Check for whitefly, mealy bugs, and scale.
