Latin Name: *Coffea arabica* Common Name: Coffee Plant

Family: Rubiaceae Origin: Ethiopia

<u>Soil:</u> Use all-purpose soil mix with perlite or vermiculite instead of sand.

<u>Temperature</u>: Daytime temperature should be 70°-80°F and nighttime temperature should be 65°-70°F.

<u>Light:</u> This plant prefers full sun with partial shade.



Moisture: Water this plant every two to three days.

<u>Fertilization:</u> This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

<u>Grooming:</u> Repot every year or two. The foliage is fragile and the leaves turn brown when rubbed against. Wash the plant regularly to keep pest problems in check.

<u>Seasonal Care:</u> Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

<u>Propagation:</u> Propagate from stem cuttings from upright growing tips, not side branches, or use seeds planted in a moist peaty soil. Use bottom heat for germination.

Pests and diseases: Check for mealy bugs, whitefly, and scale.
