## Enrollment Checklist

Please read carefully as this checklist includes important information regarding the terms of your admission. The following steps are necessary to confirm your enrollment.

### Enrollment

1. Submit your online enrollment form at [coa.edu/accepted](http://coa.edu/accepted) and nonrefundable \$300 deposit. After you matriculate at COA, this deposit will be disbursed in the following way: \$100 will be credited toward your first term tuition bill; \$100 will cover your registration fees for your time at COA, and \$100 will serve as a nonrefundable graduation fee. Online payment is available at [coa.edu/accepted](http://coa.edu/accepted). We ask that all admitted students complete the enrollment form, including those who have chosen not to attend COA.

#### Enrollment form & deposit due dates:

- Early Decision I: January 10\*
- Early Decision II: February 15\*
- Regular Decision: May 1
- Transfer Admission: May 15

*\*If you were admitted Early Decision, you must withdraw any admission applications you've submitted to other schools. You can usually withdraw your other applications by phone or email.*

2. Submit your final official transcript — Due June 30: Final admission and matriculation to COA are contingent upon successful completion of all current academic work, as well as any academic work done during deferral of admission. Final admission and matriculation are also subject to continued confidence in the quality of the student's personal character. You will not be able to register for classes until your final official transcript has been received.

### Financial Aid

If you're applying for financial aid, you will receive a financial aid award letter soon! Make sure you have submitted all of the necessary paperwork, including the FAFSA, by the deadline that applies to your application type. ### Housing & Orientation

1. Student Life Packet — Due May 1  
All first-year students are required to live in college housing. The student life packet includes a housing application, food preferences form, and more. The student life packet will be posted to [www.coa.edu/accepted](http://www.coa.edu/accepted) on March 1.
2. Outdoor Orientation Programs (OOPs) Packet — Due June 1.  
The OOPs packet will be posted to [www.coa.edu/accepted](http://www.coa.edu/accepted) by March 1.

### Course Registration

### Deferral

If you wish to defer enrollment, you may do so prior to June 1 by sending a written request to the Dean of Admission, along with an additional \$100 nonrefundable deposit (\$400 total deposit). Matriculation may be deferred for up to a full academic year, subject to the review of any college study completed during that time.
