



**COVID-19 campus status levels**





Updated 11.30.21

**Green:** Low or no COVID-19 transmission in Hancock County (less than 10 cases per 100k), zero evidence of transmission on campus

**Yellow:** High, substantial, or moderate COVID-19 transmission in Hancock County (10 or more cases per 100k) and/or limited, individual active cases of COVID-19 in the COA community

**Orange:** An outbreak of COVID-19 within the COA community (three or more linked cases of COVID-19 over a 14-day period) or multiple individual cases

**Red:** Multiple outbreaks of COVID-19 within the COA community
