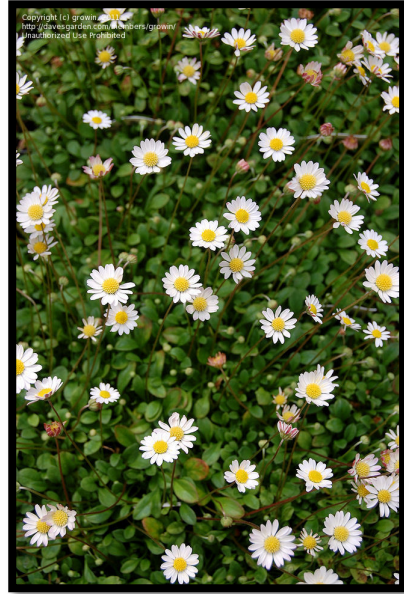


Latin Name: *Bellium minutum*
Common Name: Miniature Daisy
Family: Asteraceae
Geographic Origin: Greece



Soil: Use a well-draining soil mix.

Temperature: Daytime temperatures should be about 70°F, and night temperatures should be 50°-55°F.

Light: This plant prefers full sun to partial shade.

Moisture: Water every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every year or when plant becomes pot-bound. Remove dying plant matter.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during cold winter months.

Propagation: Propagate by division or seed.

Pests and diseases: Check for mealy bugs.
