

Latin Name: *Callisia fragrans*
Common Name: Basket Plant
Family: Commelinaceae
Geographic Origin: South Africa



Soil: Use a well-draining soil mix.

Temperature: Temperatures during the day should be between 70°-80°F and should be between 60°-70°F at night.

Light: Place this plant in an area of full to partial shade.

Moisture: Water every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every year or two. Thin out excess growth so remaining growth will be more vigorous.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months. These plants can stand weather outdoors in the summer

Propagation: Propagate from stem cuttings or plantlets.

Pests and Diseases: Check for scale and mealy bugs.

Common Name: Moses-in-the-Cradle

Family: Commelinaceae

Geographic Origin: Mexico

Soil: Use a well-draining soil mix.

Temperature: Temperatures during the day should be between 70°-80°F and should be between 60°-70°F at night.



Light: This plant prefers full sun to partial shade.

Moisture: Water every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every two years. Prune in early spring if needed.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate from stem cuttings, seeds, or division.

Pests and diseases: Check for mealy bugs, whitefly, and root rot.
