Latin Name: Cycas revoluta

Common Name: Cycad Sago Palm

Family: Cycadaceae Geographic Origin: Japan

Soil: Use a well-draining soil mix.

<u>Temperature:</u> Temperatures during the day should be between 60°-70°F and should be between 50°-60°F at night.

<u>Light:</u> This plant prefers full sun with some partial shade.



Moisture: Water every two to three days.

<u>Fertilization:</u> This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

<u>Grooming:</u> Repot every three years. This is a slow-growing plant and does not need to be repotted often. Trim off yellow leaves or branches to keep this plant looking healthy.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

<u>Propagation:</u> Propagate through seeds or plantlets.

<u>Pests and Diseases:</u> Prone to root rot, crown rot, mealybugs and scale.
