

**Latin Name:** *Cycas revoluta*  
**Common Name:** Cycad Sago Palm  
**Family:** Cycadaceae  
**Geographic Origin:** Japan

Soil: Use a well-draining soil mix.

Temperature: Temperatures during the day should be between 60°-70°F and should be between 50°-60°F at night.

Light: This plant prefers full sun with some partial shade.



Moisture: Water every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every three years. This is a slow-growing plant and does not need to be repotted often. Trim off yellow leaves or branches to keep this plant looking healthy.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate through seeds or plantlets.

Pests and Diseases: Prone to root rot, crown rot, mealybugs and scale.
