

Latin Name: *Euphorbia ingens*
Common Name: Candelabra Tree
Family: Euphorbiaceae
Geographic Origin: South Africa

****Milky sap contained in plant is highly poisonous. Contact with the toxic sap can cause skin blisters and blindness****

Soil: Create a well-draining, succulent soil mix with one part compost, one part sand, and a small amount of perlite.

Temperature: Temperatures during the day should be between 70°-80°F and should be between 60°-70°F at night.

Light: This plant should be placed in an area of full sun

Moisture: This plant should receive a thorough watering once a week during the early morning or on a cloudy day to avoid burns. Allow the soil to dry out between each watering.

Fertilization: Fertilize once a year, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizer every year.

Grooming: Repot once every year.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate through stem cuttings, plantlets, or seeds.

Pests and diseases: Check for mealy bugs, scale and root rot.
