


Latin Name: *Maranta leuconeura*
Common Name: Prayer Plant
Family: Marantaceae
Geographic Origin: Brazil

Soil: Place this plant in a peat-rich, well-drained potting mix.

Temperature: Daytime temperatures should be between 75°-85°F and nighttime temperatures should be between 65°-75°F.



Light: Place this plant in an area of full sun to partial shade.

Moisture: Water this plant every two to three days.

Fertilization: This plant should be fertilized every other week, alternating between fish and seaweed fertilizers.

Grooming: Repot every year or two. Prune when needed.

Seasonal Care: Reduce watering and fertilizing during winter months.

Propagation: Propagate through division.

Pests and Diseases: Check for mealy bugs and whitefly.
